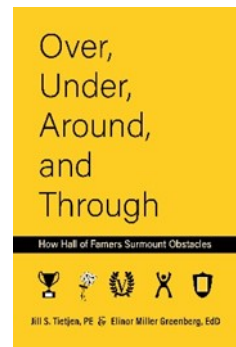
Pricing
